Admission Test to the Master Program in Molecular Biotechnology

Admission Test is scheduled on September 20 2022 at 2.00 pm.

The test is divided into two Areas, Chemistry and Biology. <u>Quiz Area 1 – Biology</u> --> includes 30 multiple-choice questions on the following disciplines: Cellular Biology, Molecular Biology, and Genetics. Time: 30 minutes <u>Quiz Area 2 – Chemistry</u> --> includes 30 multiple-choice questions on the following disciplines: Inorganic Chemistry, Organic Chemistry, and Biochemistry. Time: 30 minutes


Candidates will receive a webex link via email.

At the time indicated, candidates must connect to webex. They will be asked to show a valid ID. Once the identification procedure has been completed, candidates will be asked to access the test through the Exams Platform of the University of Torino. See the Instruction on the next page.

Candidates are required to log in to webex with their smartphone and to Exams Platform with their computer. Make sure your computer and mobile phone are charged for all time of the test.

IMPORTANT:

• The examination station must be viewable from the mobile phone as shown in the Figure



• Only the Exams Platform must be open on the computer.

• There should be nothing else on the desk besides the computer, except a paper for the exercises.

• No one must enter the room where the candidate will take the exam until the exam is completed.

The exam session will be recorded.

Results will be uploaded on the website of the Master Program in Molecular Biotechnology by September 30, 2022.
